How the "End-of-Month" Auto-Pay Program Works

On the second business day of each month, you will be charged for the total amount due for the prior month. A receipt will be emailed to you (if there is an email on file) and the charge will appear on your credit card statement. You agree that no prior notification will be provided.

*What is a CVC/CVV/CID code? These are credit card security codes consisting of three or four digits that are unique to your credit card(s). It's called the Card Verification Value (CVV), Card Verification Code (CVC) or Card Identification Number (CID), so you might hear the security code referred to as the CVV code, CVV number or CVC number. Visa, Mastercard, and Discover cardholders: Turn your card over and look at the signature box. You should see either the entire 16-digit credit card number or just the last four digits followed by a special 3-digit code. This 3-digit code is your CVV number / Card Security Code. American Express cardholders: Look for the 4-digit code printed on the front of your card just above and to the right of your main credit card number. This 4-digit code is your Card Identification Number (CID). The CID is the four-digit code printed just above the Account Number.
